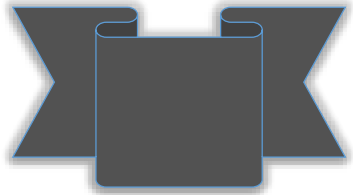

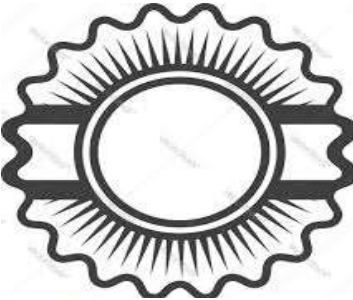

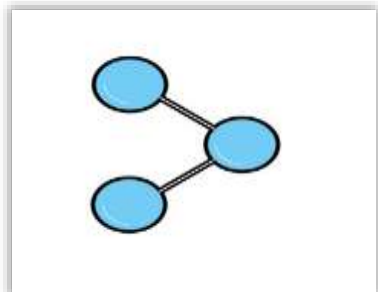
➤ **Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP)**
